Dates: Thursday, August 9 - Sunday, August 12

Lodging: Tents and Cabins on Pine Island

Meals: Thursday - Dinner

Friday & Saturday - Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Sunday - Breakfast & Lunch

Activities for children: Weather permitting, some or all of the following activities, and perhaps others, will be offered and supervised on Friday and Saturday from 9:30 - 11:30 a.m. and from 2:00 - 4:00 p.m. if there is a demand for them: rowing, sailing, canoeing, kayaking, swimming, and workshop. Note: In the event of rain, we will offer rainy day activities.

Babies: If there are very small children that need to be watched, played with or merely checked on, we will have someone available to do that during activity periods.

Adults: Adults may swim, sail, row, canoe, kayak, read, sleep, play ping pong, lie in the sun, prepare something for campfire, visit with friends, go on a picnic, and are encouraged to do any of the above with their children.

Day Trips: We will have a couple of options (hiking and canoeing) for day trips on Friday and Saturday, and we will choose which to do after gauging interest and checking the weather. The popular *KWS* cruise to Belgrade Lakes will certainly be repeated.

Evenings: Each night after dinner we will have "Boats Out," then campfire (songs, games, skits, etc.), followed by socializing in Honk Hall.

Cost: Adults - \$290

Under 6 - Free

(The maximum fee for a family will be \$1000)

Note: This price includes all food, activities and trips. **Wine will be available at dinner, but no other alcoholic beverages will be allowed on the island. Smoking is not permitted on the island.**
