2010 REGISTRATION AGREEMENT

Expectation and standards. The camper and parents agree to abide by all of the rules and policies established by Pine Island Camp, including without limitation those relating to enrollment and withdrawal, and understand that trust, communication, honesty and integrity are keys to a successful camp community.

Payment terms.

↪ Tuition	\$6850
↪ Incidental account deposit (balance to be returned to you in September)	\$150
↪ Sibling discount — for second and each additional child	\$500

Payment schedule.

↪ Nonrefundable deposit, due with registration form	\$500
↪ February 15 — half of remaining tuition due	\$3175
↪ May 15 — tuition balance and incidental account deposit due	\$3325

Withdrawal. Parents are responsible for the entire tuition if a camper withdraws after June 1. If a camper withdraws before that date, tuition and fees, excluding the \$500 nonrefundable deposit, will be refundable. If the camp is able to fill the spot vacated by a withdrawing camper, the director may in his sole discretion decide to refund tuition and/or deposit. Any deposit retained after a registered camper withdraws will be added to the camp's scholarship fund.

Dismissal of camper. The Camp reserves the right to send home, without tuition reduction or refund, any camper whose behavior is deemed unacceptable or detrimental to the best interests of the camp or camp community.

Medical care. Medical care provided by the camp medic is included in the tuition. Parents grant Pine Island Camp permission to use medical care (including dental, orthodontic, and optical care) outside of camp should the director deem such treatment necessary. All expenses for outside medical care will be paid by parents.

Permission to participate. Parents hereby grant their son permission to participate in camp activities, excursions, and wilderness trips. Parents acknowledge that this program will take place in outdoor and wilderness settings and that there is a risk of serious physical injury inherent in participation in programs in such settings.

Images. Parents give Pine Island Camp permission to copyright or publish photographs, movies, videos, letters or tape recordings of their son and to use those images in camp publications, promotional materials, camp website, and any other camp-related promotional materials or projects. Children will not be identified by name on the website or in the brochure.

Belongings. Pine Island Camp is not responsible for campers' belongings or equipment while in transit or at camp.
